Attendance Policy

Good attendance is absolutely essential in school because it promotes academic success. We have adopted an Attendance Policy which applies to all students at BB&C Christian Academy. It is very important that they are on time for optimum instructional time.

Attendance Standards

- A. All students are expected to be on time and present each day school is in session during the year.
- B. Parents must call the school on the 1st day of a student's absence. If the school does not receive a phone call, the school will call each day to verify the absence. If a parent is not reached, the student must bring a note upon their return or the absence will be unexcused.
- C. The Attendance Review Committee (ARC), which consist of the CEO/owner, Principal, and classroom teachers work with the parents to decrease the number of absences. Students who have a pattern of excessive excused or unexcused absences which exceeds 3 days within a month will be contacted by ARC. If this does not remedy, other alternative may be pursued.

The ARC shall implement interventions that best address the problem including, but not limited to the following:

- Student Counseling
- Attendance Contract
- Referral to Other Agencies
- Other Interventions

Excused Absences

- Illness
- Death in Immediate Family
- Medical Appointment
- Observance of Religious

Improving Attendance

BB&C Christian Academy plans for increasing student attendance includes careful monitoring a student's absences, notification of parents, review board as needed, and attendance incentives.
